Question 3:

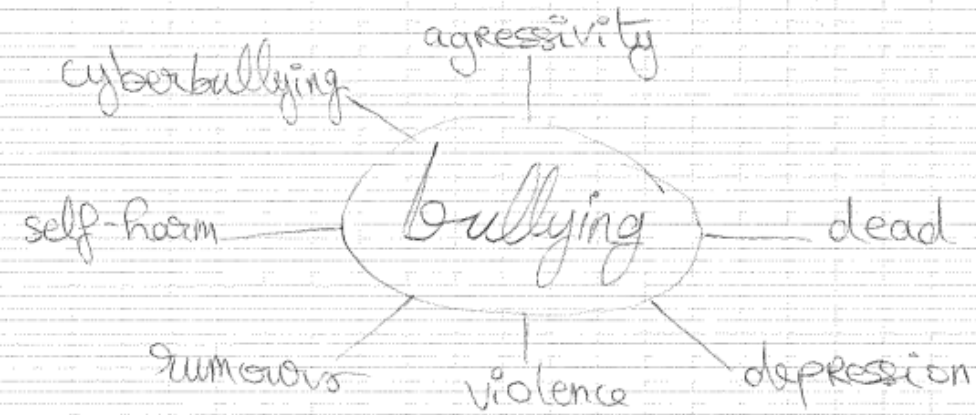
Have you defended someone in a bullying situation?

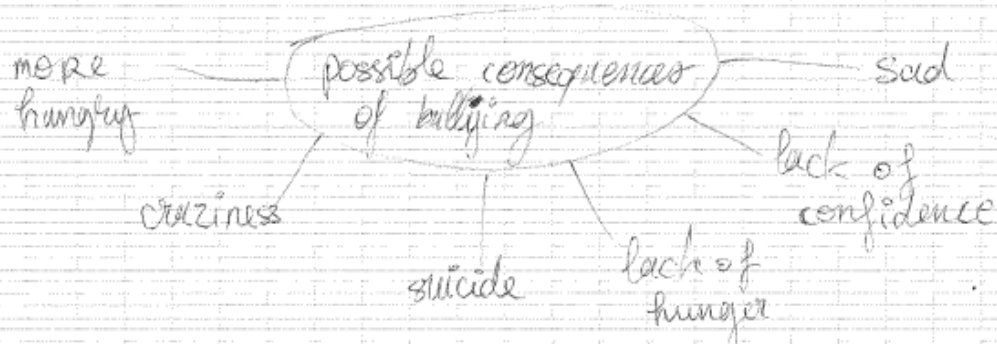


There are "3018" and "Parle, je t'écoute" and "Nourion La Main Tendue" to combat bullying.

Bullying at school
